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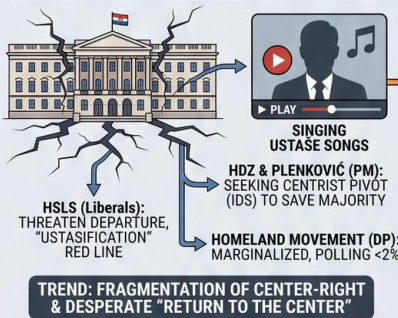

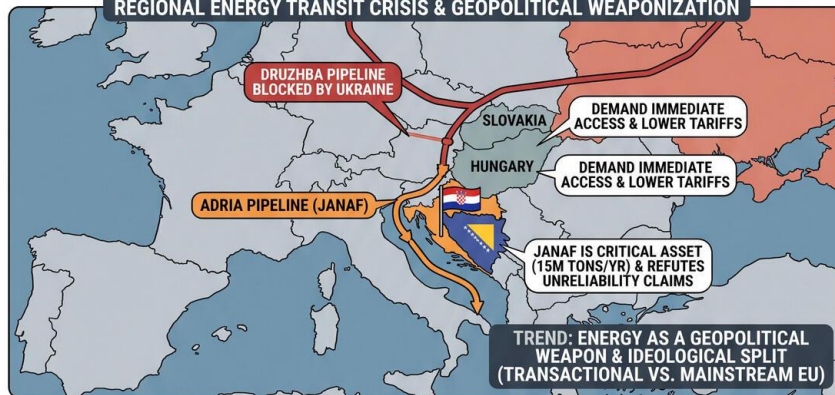

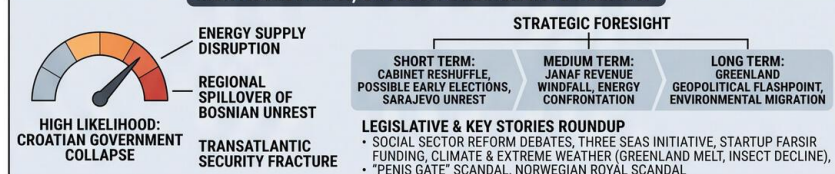

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CROATIA FACES COALITION COLLAPSE AMID FAR-RIGHT SCANDAL AND STRATEGIC TRANSATLANTIC REALIGNMENT

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The Croatian government is currently navigating a severe internal crisis triggered by the emergence of a video featuring Minister **Josip Dabro** singing songs glorifying the **Ustaše** regime. This development has pushed the junior coalition partner, **HSLS**, to the brink of departure, forcing Prime Minister **Andrej Plenković** to seek a strategic pivot toward centrist and liberal factions to maintain his parliamentary majority. This domestic instability occurs as the **Munich Security Conference** highlights a fundamental shift in the transatlantic alliance, with the U.S. administration signaling that the **post-WWII order** has effectively ended, demanding European strategic emancipation.

Simultaneously, regional tensions are escalating over energy transit as **Hungary and Slovakia** demand immediate access to the **Adria pipeline** (JANAF) following the cessation of Russian oil flows via Ukraine. Domestically, the government is also

struggling with institutional decay in the social sector, marked by a critical shortage of **personal assistants** and legal defeats regarding disability benefits. This convergence of ideological scandal, regional energy blackmail, and administrative failure suggests a fragile state capacity, with leadership prioritizing political survival through a desperate "return to the center."

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

The Dabro Scandal and Coalition Fragility

- A video of Minister **Josip Dabro** (Homeland Movement - DP) singing "Grobница od zlata," a song glorifying [Ante Pavelić](#), has ignited a political firestorm.
- The liberal **HSLS** has threatened to exit the coalition, citing ["ustasification"](#) as a red line they can no longer tolerate.
- Prime Minister Plenković is reportedly [consulting with centrist parties](#) such as **IDS** and independent representatives to secure a new, more moderate majority.

U.S. Foreign Policy Pivot at Munich

- U.S. Secretary of State **Marco Rubio** delivered a landmark speech in Munich, declaring the [old order is gone](#) and that Europe must secure its own future.
- The U.S. administration is pressuring **NATO** allies to take a leadership role in their own defense while expressing skepticism regarding any new [Iran nuclear deal](#).

Regional Energy Transit Crisis

- Hungary and Slovakia have sent a formal [request to Croatia](#) to enable the transport of Russian oil through the **Adria (JANAF)** pipeline.

- This follows Ukraine's move to [block oil deliveries](#) through the Druzhba pipeline, placing Croatia in a position of significant regional leverage.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Diplomacy & Statecraft

- Secretary of State **Marco Rubio** is on a European tour, visiting Bratislava and Budapest to strengthen ties with [conservative allies](#) like **Viktor Orban**.
- The **Three Seas Initiative**, which Croatia will chair in Dubrovnik this April, is being promoted as a key [energy and infrastructure](#) platform.

Leadership Dynamics & Governance

- The appointment of **Alen Ružić** as the new Minister of Labor and Social Policy is overshadowed by a Constitutional Court [ruling on disability rights](#).
- The administration is facing criticism for the [slow implementation](#) of the "inclusive add-on" (inkluzivni dodatak) reform.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Fragmentation of the Center-Right

Prime Minister Plenković's attempt to balance a "modern European" **HDZ** with the hard-right **Homeland Movement (DP)** has reached its logical breaking point. The **Dabro scandal** has provided a pretext for Plenković to marginalize the DP, whose [polling support has collapsed](#) to below 2%. The move toward liberal/centrist allies like **IDS** or **Matija Posavec** is framed not just as a survival tactic, but as a **"return to the center"** to appease international (specifically EU) concerns about [proustaša sentiment](#) within the government.

Energy as a Geopolitical Weapon

The **Druzhba pipeline** blockage by Ukraine is forcing a reorganization of Central European energy flows. Croatia is positioned as a **"energy hub"** through **JANAF**, but this is met with suspicion by Hungary, which portrays Croatian transit as a [rat profiteering](#) exercise. The subtext is a deeper ideological split within the EU, where Hungary and Slovakia are increasingly aligned with a **transactional U.S. posture** while Croatia attempts to remain within the core European mainstream.

INTERNAL DYNAMICS & DOMESTIC INSTABILITY

Croatia

- Institutional decay is evident in the [social care sector](#), where the lack of personal assistants is preventing the implementation of basic rights for people with disabilities.
- The government is under fire for [ignoring court rulings](#) that favored citizens seeking social benefits, leading to administrative "deafness" and legal liabilities.

Bosnia and Herzegovina

- Civil unrest in **Sarajevo** has led to the [resignation of Prime Minister Nihad Uk](#) following a tragic tram accident.
- The protests have morphed into a broader movement against **systemic corruption** and the failure of public services, with citizens demanding ["justice"](#) and systemic change.

EXTERNAL DYNAMICS & GLOBAL POSTURE

The international system is portrayed as **fracturing**, with the U.S. moving toward a **strategic isolationism** that favors bilateral deals over traditional alliances. The framing of the **Munich Security Conference** suggests that **Europe is being abandoned** to its own devices, with Sec State Rubio calling for a [restoration and renewal](#) of Western strength that is not dependent on American intervention. Croatia is attempting to project power as a **regional energy savior** while simultaneously reacting defensively to the domestic "far-right" tag that threatens its standing in the EU.

THE ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT

The economic outlook is characterized by a significant influx of capital into the **tech sector** and a reorganization of **energy markets** due to geopolitical conflict. The domestic Croatian economy remains constrained by a **chronic labor shortage** in the service and care sectors.

- **Venture Capital:** The Croatian startup **Farsir** (financial planning software) has secured a [Series A round of \\$7 million](#), signaling resilience in the local IT scene.
- **Energy Costs:** Hungary and Slovakia are pressuring Croatia to lower [transit tariffs](#) for the JANA pipeline, which they currently deem prohibitively expensive compared to Russian Druzhba rates.
- **Social Spending:** The government has spent [1.7 billion euros](#) on inclusive additions, but faces a backlog of 103,000 unresolved claims.

LEADERSHIP CHANGES

Significant leadership shifts are occurring in Croatia and Bosnia, driven by both scandal and civil unrest.

- **Alen Ružić:** Nominated as the new **Minister of Labor and Social Policy** in Croatia, replacing **Marin Piletić**. Ružić's primary challenge will be addressing the [disability rights crisis](#).

- **Nihad Uk:** The Prime Minister of the Sarajevo Canton has [resigned](#) in the face of public protests following a student's death in a tram accident.
- **Josip Dabro:** Currently the **Minister of Agriculture**, Dabro is the primary target of coalition partners and the opposition for his [pro-Ustaše](#) behavior.
- **Marco Rubio:** Portrayed as the **architect of a new U.S. global posture**, acting as a bridge between the Trump administration and skeptical [European allies](#).

EDITORIAL POSTURE & STORY HIERARCHY

The lead story for the day is the **Dabro Scandal**, which the network uses to question the fundamental stability of the Croatian government. - **Andrej Plenković:** Framed as a **competent but besieged** leader who is "neutralizing" his right flank through ["sonization"](#) (political absorption and destruction).
- **Viktor Orban:** Portrayed as **opportunistic and stable**, successfully leveraging his relationship with the Trump administration to secure [U.S. investment](#) and oil transit.
- **Donald Trump:** Portrayed as **transcendent**, with his influence shaping European security and energy policy even from Washington, through [administrators like Rubio](#).
- **Russia:** Framed as **foe and persistent threat**, though implicitly capable of deal-making with the U.S. behind Europe's back to [end the war](#) on its own terms.

INFORMATION WARFARE ENVIRONMENT

The current environment is saturated with **narrative seeding** regarding the "Ustaše threat." The Homeland Movement (DP) and its supporters are attempting to **deflect** by highlighting patriotic intent, while the opposition is **weaponizing the video** to paint the entire government as ["pro-Ustaše"](#) on the international stage. Simultaneously, Hungary is conducting an **information operation** against JANAF, labeling it a [rat-like profit enterprise](#) to delegitimize Croatian energy transit and maintain its dependence on Russian sources.

HYPOTHESES AND FUTURE OUTLOOK

- **Coalition Realignment:** Prime Minister Plenković will likely **expel the Homeland Movement** from the cabinet within weeks, replacing them with **IDS** and the **Posavec** group to project a moderate, pro-EU image.
- **Energy Confrontation:** Tensions with Hungary over the **Adria pipeline** will escalate to the **European Commission**, as Croatia uses its transit monopoly to extract political concessions from Budapest regarding Ukraine.
- **Transatlantic Shift:** Europe will accelerate the creation of a **European Defense Union** as Rubio's "Strategic Emancipation" message sinks in, leading to a permanent **reduction in U.S. troop levels** on the continent.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect a cabinet reshuffle in Croatia and potential **early elections** if Plenković fails to secure centrist support. Social unrest in Sarajevo may spread to other Bosnian cities if systemic reform is not immediate.

- **Transatlantic Security Fracture:** Medium Likelihood. Triggers: Sudden U.S. withdrawal from NATO commitments. Impact: Potential for increased Russian aggression in Eastern Europe. Mitigations: Rapid buildup of European autonomous military capacity.
- **Environmental Migration from Sea-Level Rise:** Long-term but certain. Triggers: Total melting of the Greenland ice sheet. Impact: 7.2m [global sea level rise](#), destroying coastal cities. Mitigations: Unprecedented global carbon reduction and infrastructure fortification.

GAPS & BLIND SPOTS

- **Military Readiness:** The transcripts mention a transition to Western military technology but provide no data on the **actual operational readiness** of the Croatian armed forces.
- **Economic Impact of Energy Pivot:** While JANAF is discussed, the **impact on Croatian consumers** of potentially losing Hungarian energy cooperation is ignored.

The Dabro "False Flag": One alternative hypothesis is that the Dabro video was **leaked by Plenković's own faction** to create a "principled" reason to break with the Homeland Movement (DP), whose presence in government has become an international liability ahead of the Three Seas chairing. This would allow for a more stable, EU-friendly coalition without the "traitor" label from the right.

Black Swan Event: "Penis Gate" Escalation: What appears to be a bizarre sports scandal involving **hyaluronic acid injections** in ski jumping ["Penis Gate"](#) could lead to a massive systemic corruption investigation within the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and the IOC, revealing deep technological doping practices that **collapse**

- **Capital Allocation:** Focus on **Croatian IT and AI startups**, following the Farsir Series A success, as the sector shows high growth potential despite political volatility.
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Monitor for new **anti-Ustaše** and totalitarianism legislation which may impact corporate sponsorship of traditional cultural events.
