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TAIWAN NAVIGATES TECH TRANSFORMATION AND GEOPOLITICAL TENSION AMIDST LUNAR NEW YEAR DOMESTIC TRAGEDIES

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The broadcasting cycle for February 17-18, 2026, reveals a nation at a strategic crossroads, aggressively pursuing technological sovereignty through **artificial intelligence integration** while grappling with significant domestic instability and regional security threats. The narrative is dominated by the government's push for "Smart Taiwan" initiatives, showcasing AI applications in **precision agriculture**, medical surgery virtualization, and emergency search-and-rescue. The focus on North Korea's military parade acts as a **distraction** from more immediate cross-strait tensions that might be too sensitive during the holiday.

GEOPOLITICAL FRAMING

Global actors are framed through their impact on Taiwan's security and economic standing, with a clear dichotomy between democratic partners and authoritarian threats.

COUNTRIES and LEADERS

- **Taiwan (Lai Ching-te):** Portrayed as a **pious, tech-savvy defender** of traditional values and modern innovation [at the temples](#).
