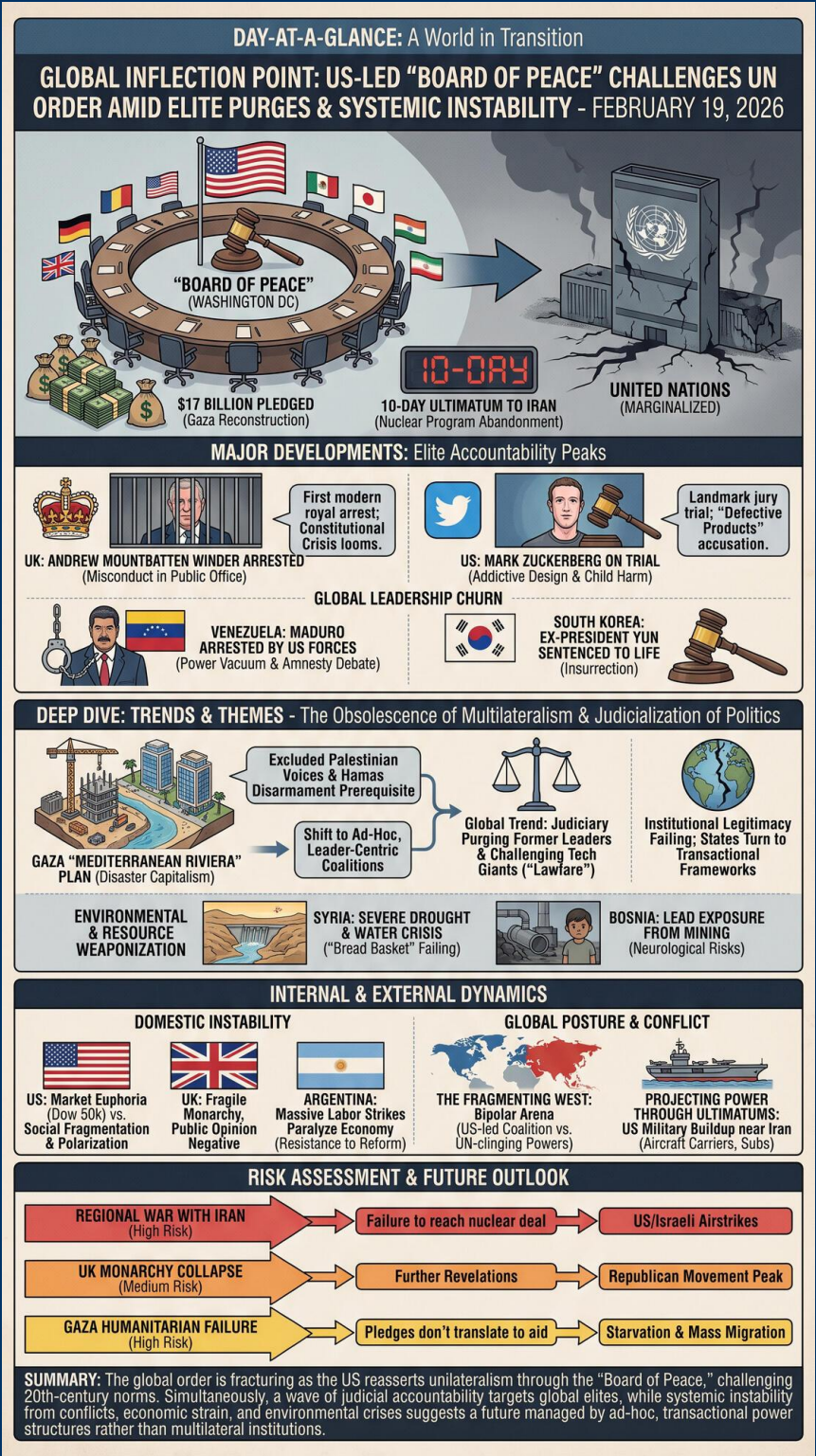

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US-LED "BOARD OF PEACE" MOVES
TO SUPERSEDE UNITED NATIONS
WHILE GLOBAL ELITE
ACCOUNTABILITY PEAKS AMIDST
SYSTEMIC INSTABILITY

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

February 19, 2026, marks a potential inflection point in the global order, characterized by the aggressive rollout of a US-centric, transactional diplomatic framework for the Middle East that seeks to marginalize the United Nations. The inaugural meeting of the "Board of Peace" in Washington, chaired by President Donald Trump, has secured [billions in pledges](#) from over 40 nations for the reconstruction of Gaza. However, the project is marred by the conspicuous [exclusion of Palestinian voices](#) and a 10-day ultimatum issued to Iran to abandon its nuclear program, raising the immediate risk of a regional conflagration. This diplomatic maneuver appears to be an attempt to replace traditional "orthodoxy" with a business-model governance structure where membership is contingent on financial investment.

Simultaneously, the day is defined by a peak in elite accountability and judicial purges across three continents. In the United Kingdom, the [unprecedented arrest](#) of Andrew Mountbatten Winder (formerly Prince Andrew) on suspicion of misconduct in public office marks the first such action against a senior royal in modern history, potentially triggering a constitutional crisis. In the United States, Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg faces a landmark jury trial regarding [addictive design](#) and harm to children, while the arrest of former Venezuelan President Nicholas Maduro by US special forces creates a power vacuum currently being filled by an interim government debating a [sweeping amnesty law](#).

The broader international landscape remains volatile. South Korea has finalized the [sentencing of former President Yun](#) to life in prison for his 2024 insurrection, while the United Nations has officially identified "hallmarks of genocide" in the Sudanese city of [Al Fasha](#). These developments, coupled with massive labor strikes in Argentina and severe environmental crises in Syria and Bosnia, suggest a world where institutional legitimacy is failing, and states are increasingly turning to ad-hoc, leader-centric coalitions to manage systemic collapse.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

Establishment of the "Board of Peace" and Middle East Realignment

- The inaugural meeting in Washington DC saw pledges totaling over **\$17 billion** (\$10B from the US, \$7B from nine other nations) for the "20-point Gaza Peace Plan" [relief package](#).

- The Board is framed as a **replacement for UN architecture**, with legal experts noting it operates as a self-standing treaty that violates principles of sovereign equality by granting specific rights to high-level [investors](#).
