TRUMP'S TEN-DAY ULTIMATUM AND NAVAL BUILDUP SIGNAL IMMEDIATE RISK OF KINETIC CONFLICT WITH IRAN AMID DOMESTIC DIGITAL INSURGENCY

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

February 20, 2026, marks a critical inflection point in the escalating confrontation between the United States and the Islamic Republic of Iran. President Donald Trump has issued a **ten-day ultimatum** for Tehran to agree to a "meaningful" new deal or face unspecified "bad things," which analysts and leaked military reports suggest involve **limited kinetic strikes** against nuclear and military infrastructure.
