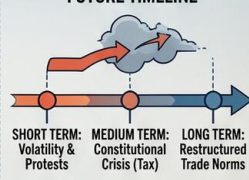

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### GLOBAL TRADE VOLATILITY AND CATALAN FISCAL STALEMATE THREATEN INSTITUTIONAL STABILITY

#### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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The global landscape on February 21, 2026, is characterized by a high-stakes convergence of legal warfare in the United States and a deepening fiscal crisis in Catalonia. The US Supreme Court's decision to [invalidate existing tariffs](#) has triggered an aggressive retaliatory posture from Donald Trump, who has proposed a **10% global tariff** on all imports. This maneuver, aimed at bypassing judicial constraints through executive emergency powers, has injected severe uncertainty into international markets and forced European partners to reconsider their trade posture. Simultaneously, in Catalonia, the **refusal of the Spanish central government** to cede control over income tax (IRPF) collection has brought budget negotiations to a [complete standstill](#), threatening the survival of President Salvador Illa's administration and highlighting the limits of the current "investidura" agreements.

- **The 10% Global "Trade Shock":** Trump's global tariff will trigger **immediate inflationary pressure** in the US and retaliatory measures from the EU, potentially leading to a "super-inflation" scenario by late 2026.

- **Defense Commodity Boom:** The shift to low-cost drone defense will create a **new industrial sector** in Poland and Ukraine, siphoning investment away from traditional aerospace giants.
